

The names of the streets at the former Darby Kaserne Fuerth

1 Dr.-Meyer-Spreckels-Straße

Mrs. Meyer-Spreckels was bearer of the Golden Citizen Medal (“Buergermedaille”). She was leader of the CSU-party in the City Council after WWII and was engaged in building social homes.

2 Kellermannstraße

Bernhard Kellermann, a famous author (1879-1951), born in Fuerth.

3 Isaak-Loewi-Straße

He lived from 1801 to 1873 and supported the integration of the Jews in Fuerth as Chief Rabbi.

4 Ullsteinstraße

Leopold Ullstein (1826-1899), born in Fuerth, was the biggest German newspaper publisher at the end of the 19th century.

5 Krautheimerstraße

The mother, Martha K., founded the „Krautheimer Krippe“ in 1912, a station for baby care. The son, Dr. Richard K., was a famous art historian, specialized in ancient Rome.

6 Liesl-Kießling-Straße

The sister of the founder of the Quelle mail-order company, Gustav Schickedanz. She was engaged in the integration of the WWII refugees here in Fuerth and other charitable actions. Bearer of the Golden Citizen Medal.

7 Leupoldstraße

Mrs. Leupold was bearer of the Golden Citizen Medal because of her charitable donations

The other streets at Darby were named after planets.
