

O'Brien Barracks in Schwabach

on Sunday, 19. July2015

at 13:00h

at the former main gate of O'Brien Barracks Museumsstraße 1, Schwabach.



Schwabach - once part of the Nuernberg US-Army Military Community –hosted American soldiers for 47 years before the total closure of the Schwabach military facilities in May 1992. O'Brien was home for the 1st Squadron, 1st Regiment Cavalry (1/1 Cav) and 2nd Battalion, 52nd Air Defense Artillery Brigade.

In the course of a guided tour we will be able to see what has become of O'Brien Barracks after 23 years. Many buildings still remind of the Americans while others have been completely renovated. Marco Froemter, our Club president, who is organizing the tour, will take



you back in time with stories, pictures and a nice walking tour "on post".

After the tour the City of Schwabach offers an exclusive look behind the curtain to have an authentic look at the skilled crafts of a gold-beater. After his demonstration there is plenty of time to see the Museum about the history of the City of Schwabach (including the history of the US-Army in the city).

After the tour you will have the chance to have a coffee at the Cafeteria inside the museum or enjoy a typical Pizza at "Mike's Pizza" American GI's loved for decades.



Another event in July will bring us again to a location of long lasting German-American relationship, accompanied by a reading of **Kerstin Trimble from Annandale, Virginia**. She is a German-American author (and born in Nuremberg) and would like to offer us a reading from her latest novel "Tale of Transgression". Especially for Fuerth and Nuernberg citizens with relationship to America the novel may be a nostalgic book tour: The story tells about an unequal German-American couple fighting for their difficult love around the Merrell Barracks in the 1950s, and a gang of genuine Nuremberg "Frecker" whose forays into the post-war city engage them in precarious cloak and dagger operations. The novel is written in German (partly "Fraenkisch") and English.

As we would like to invite you to this reading at the "1. Golf Club Fuerth" we'll seize the opportunity to present you some information about this interesting location. Marco Froemter and Bernd Jesussek will inform us about the former airport, founded during the "Kaiserreich", the first civilian airport for the whole area in the 1920ies, the training airport for the "Luftwaffe", the later Monteith Barracks and its conversion to a living and industrial area.
